We are happy to hear from many of you that you were able to do this without problems. However, we know some of you have had difficulties and situations that are slightly different requiring contact with OTIP. I was able to help one member directly on the phone and we were lucky it did not take anytime at all as we were answered right away. But I know we also had a member spend over an hour waiting for help....much like the cable or phone company.

Please take note if you did not have benefit coverage now is the time you may be able to enroll. If you were part time you are prorated but there is no longer a minimum amount of contract required to get benefits. This also includes those on Part Time LTO contracts.

We have learned acupuncture is no longer covered unless you obtain it through another form such as massage, chiro or physio. We have also learned over age student coverage for benefits ends earlier than our previous coverage. We are trying to monitor any other losses as we understand each one is relevant to each member differently. Please inform us if you have any difficulty or concerns.

Our members on WSIB, LTD or unpaid leaves all have unique situations and most have required some assistance from OTIP or OECTA. We also learned Sunlife disabled the website earlier than they needed to. Please mail in your receipts directly asap.

OECTA AGM 2017 FEES

The hot topic again this year was the situation of our association financially and our union fees. OECTA Provincially has been hampered for a few reasons but here are the major ones. There was little permanent fee increases during our years of 3% annual wage gains. Items would be passed at AGMs by the membership but no associated increase in the fee. Perhaps the most important our actual FTE membership was not reflected in how we prepared the budget. As each year we loss teachers due to declining enrollment we did not change our estimated membership causing us to lose several millions over the last few years.

We have explained how our OECTA fees are the lowest of our OTF affiliates and we have the most return to the locals. If this was to continue it would be a recipe for disaster. The AGM approved a \$100 increase to the base fee and also attach % increase to the fee after each annual raise we receive which means no raise no fee increase. This will go a long way to ensure we can offer great programs like the Beginning Teachers Conference and Leadership while we continue to maintain our core services of Member Legal Defense, Collective Bargaining and Grievances.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Provincial OECTA was given a mandate from the Winter Council of Presidents to make Violence in our Schools a key priority. This mandate was a joint Ottawa and Wellington motion that was passed by a very large majority if not unanimous.

In order to ensure that the Gov't and the Boards realize what we all know is fact we need to be more diligent than ever in filling out the proper



paper work. This means that at times that two forms may be needed to be filled out.

A) The Safe School Form Must be filled out any time a student behaves in a manner for which suspension could be the result—this includes IEP students and behaviour students.

B) An incident form must be filled out any time you were the target of an act that is some form of physical or verbal assault or attempted assault including spits and thrown items.


