COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UPDATE

We are now into our third month without a contract. We are also facing very new procedures as we continue to deal with Bill 122 and Provincial Bargaining. Every single member should have received an email blast on Friday Oct 31st. This is the tenth bulletin from Provincial aptly named PB Email Blast 10. This email and the nine before are your way to stay informed with the process. It has outlined the 18 articles that are to be dealt with at the Central Provincial Bargaining Table and the 5 outstanding articles that the Gov't, Trustees and OECTA still disagree on. This now moves to waiting period with the OLRB (Labour Relations Board).

As you can see we are barely started in our negotiation process. We can not start ANY local negotiations until the Central Negotiations are complete. OECTA is hoping for the best but quietly preparing for the worst. We need to realize we do not have a contract. We need to realize the Gov't has not offered any new salary money. We need to realize that there will be a push to strip some of our contract rights. You need to make sure you are getting these email blasts as that will be your means to vote for a Provincial contract.
