# Staffing and Cuts

The Staffing picture is clearer than last month as up to 36 individuals face potential lay offs as permanent teachers. Today we are still waiting for our experts to interpret the GSNs that the Gov't released last week. The 'Technical Paper' which follows the GSNs, gives Boards the actual breakdown of funding they will receive. We already know per pupil funding was cut. We cautiously wait for the details that will allow the Board to re-staff the Central Staff and Program Department.

The Board will then have the First Posting and we will know how many teachers will not be in danger of being redundant. We also hope our student population continues to grow as has been past practice at this time of year. These two factors will largely determine how many of our colleagues remain redundant.

The timelines for this was posted on our OECTA group email and was also released by H R through the administrators. After Central Staff is done the Board will inform OECTA of who is redundant and who is surplus. Then the Board and OECTA will place the surplus staff together (the actual process still needs to be discussed). Finally, Redundant teachers will then be recalled into LTOs according to seniority and qualifications.

Once all Redundant teachers have an LTO normal LTO process and procedures will return and postings will continue as normal through the summer and beyond.

#### Unit AGM and Local Elections 2019-20

The Unit AGM will take place on Thurs May 16 at the OECTA Office at 4:30. In addition to elections the Unit will examine the budget and receive member committee reports. The acclaimed positions are

#### Contract 101 : Did you know?

School Based Staffing Best Practices: Principals will meet with the OECTA Rep(s) or OECTA local designates regarding school based staffing a minimum of two times per school year, with the rep initiating the meeting request at least one week in advance of the proposed meeting date.

Your Staff Rep or Staff Designates should be requesting these meetings at each local school site now. You are entitled to receive the structures and be prepared to discuss any concerns the staff has or concerns individual teachers may have to bring to the Principal's attention.

Ask your Rep if they have asked your Principal to set up the meeting today?
