The month of June has finally arrived. We are all wrapped up with our 'normal' duties of year end activities, graduations, late spring sports, arts and clubs. On top of that we are in the midst of our core duties of year end assessments, culminating activities, tests and exams as we prepare for report cards and exams. Remember we are all in this together and we are all under the same timelines, stresses and pressures. Be there for your colleagues and each other this month to help everyone make it to the finish line.

June is here. We are now 10 months without a contract. We are still in negotiations with the Board and Province at the Provincial Bargaining Table. We are in the middle of the mediation stage. Which is not the stage of conciliation that places a deadline on a strike action or lockout. That means we will likely not reach a legal strike situation until September at the earliest.

Though, if we look at how our affiliates are handling their negotiations then there is not much hope that the draconian cuts will be withdrawn. We need to all realize what is at stake for our vocation. The future of how teachers are treated by the Boards, Governments and Administrators is all at risk. Contract victories since the 1980's are in jeopardy and may be totally wiped away.....and this is only the first step in the new world of Provincial Bargaining.

We had an overwhelming strike mandate of 94 % and our Wellington Unit was higher than the provincial average! We need to stay together and support each other with whatever lays ahead.

Reminder that June has three pay periods. We skip a pay period between August and September by one week. Information from our OECTA bank consultant is on the first class conference to assist all of us in the possible turmoil ahead. I, personally, am just as concerned about the possible actions to take place but I am immensely proud to represent all of you as President.

Staff Rep Elections and Bargaining

Normally we have time to give members a few weeks in September but with the state of negotiations that confronts us we are asking Reps to be elected by Friday September 11th if not earlier.

We ask all Staff Reps that are leaving their site to please have a brief meeting to have an interim Rep in place for the summer or to have their elections in June for next year. In some cases there are new members arriving who have worked as Reps and you may want to see if they wish to stand for the position.

The Staff Rep is the front line eyes and ears of our Association. They communicate between their site and the Executive. They take notes during any meetings between members and the administrators. They share ideas to solve problems and they help members with a variety of advice on contract issues. The Staff Rep is crucial to a strong OECTA presence in every school and they chair each monthly staff OECTA meeting.

Staff Reps must be selected during an OECTA <u>only</u> meeting. OECTA Reps are never to be on a sign up sheet as Extra-Curricular. The meeting must be announced in advance. If there is more than one candidate for the position there must be an election. All elections will be by secret ballot. The Executive is available to help in any election if a staff wishes assistance.

Secondary and larger Elementary schools usually have two Reps. It is suggested that every site have a back up Rep to attend meetings if the Rep can't make a meeting.

Meetings for the Reps generally take place on the last Monday of the month except January. There are no Rep meetings in December or June.

We ask all Reps to be ready to attend a meeting after school Sept 3rd (PD Day).

AUGUST NOTES START DATE AND PAY

We hope by now everyone has read the several notices we put out for the past few months on our back to school start dates and the implications our calendar cycle has on our Pay Periods:

- The first day we must be back to work is Thursday Sept. 3rd. Yes we are back to work prior to Labour Day. The good news is it is a PD Day and NOT a day with students as has happened once before.
- The first day back with students will be after Labour Day on Tuesday Sept. 8th. Please make your summer plans accordingly.
- Our pay periods, as happens every six or seven years is once again affected by a gap between our last pay in August and our first pay in September. We will miss a week.
- Our last pay is Tuesday Aug. 25th
- Our first pay back is Tuesday Sept. 15th

Please plan accordingly for the gap and any potential work disruptions in September.

2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR

Provincial OECTA has reported on the news last week that September will not be 'business as usual'. Teachers need to be cognitive that in addition to the legality of being in a legal Strike Action which could have 'Work to Rule' issues or full withdrawal of service; we could also be locked out by the Board. Teachers need to prepare for the Fall accordingly.

If you have questions regarding extra-curriculars, school trips, conferences and PD they may all be directed to your Reps or the Executive.

We don't know the status of the Joint PD (OECTA and Board) Funds. We don't know what the implications will be for CODE, WFMP, Ministry initiatives and other Board initiated PD in the Fall. OECTA will wait to see how negotiations continue to develop during the rest of June and through the summer. If in doubt, ask.

CONTRACT 101

Q Why can't we have more say in our classes or grade assignments?

A Unfortunately, our contract gives us (and most teachers) very little say on what we teach or what grades/subjects and courses we are assigned. There are historical reasons for this one of course is that our Principals were in OECTA with us until 1997.

Q What rights do I have then when it comes to course assignments or grade classes?

A Well your seniority does ensure that you are indeed able to remain at your school site. You have the right to teach a subject or grade that you are qualified to teach. If you and the principal mutually agree you can teach a subject or grade that you aren't qualified to teach but this is becoming more rare. The days of P/J teachers being assigned grade 7/8 are becoming part of our past. If you are assigned a class or grade that you are unqualified for and wish advice please call the Unit OECTA Office.

Q When can I call the OECTA Office? A Whenever you want, call early call often :)
